### **Teams:**

1 x 10 person team

Singles, Pairs, Triples, Fours

### **Format:**

5 rounds of play using a scattered draw.

There is no freedom of movement allowed between disciplines. Player positions may be changed within a discipline but not between disciplines.

Game Length:	Singles	21 shots
	Pairs	18 ends (3 bowls)
	Triples	18 ends (2 bowls)
	Fours	15 ends (2 bowls)
	<b>Time limit</b>	2 hours for all disciplines

### **Scoring:**

Result determined by wins (1 point) and draws (0.5 point). If equal then on differential over all rounds, if still equal then by most 'shots for' over all rounds.

## **Restricting the Movement of Players during Play:**

Singles	the opponents after delivery of their 3 <sup>rd</sup> and 4 <sup>th</sup> bowls
Pairs	the Leads after delivery of their 3 <sup>rd</sup> bowls the Skips after delivery of their 2 <sup>nd</sup> and 3 <sup>rd</sup> bowls
Triples	the Leads and Seconds after delivery of their 2 <sup>nd</sup> bowl the Skips after delivery of each of their bowls
Fours	the Leads after the second player in their team has delivered their 2 <sup>nd</sup> bowl the Seconds and Thirds after delivery of their 2 <sup>nd</sup> bowl the Skips after delivery of each of their bowls

In exceptional and limited circumstances, a Singles player can ask the Marker for permission to walk up to the head, or a Skip can ask that a player walks up to the head earlier than described above.

## **General Conditions:**

- In the event of a kill the jack is to be respotted.
- All games are to be played in accordance with Laws of the Sport of Bowls, NZ Domestic Regulations and Conditions of Play.
- The Controlling Body/ Tournament Manager shall have the right to alter or amend the schedule and/or playing conditions as deemed necessary.
- Should bowls stickers be used all team bowls must have stickers.
- Scorecards are to be filled in including the names of players and to be signed by both skips at the completion of the game.
- Each individual rink will toss before the start of each game to decide who will have the mat.
- Smoking/ vaping is not permitted on/near the green during the event. Host's club smoking policy to be adhered to.
- Phones are to be switched off or turned to silent mode.
- A Manager's meeting will be held at 3.30pm on day 1

**Catering:** Lunches will be provided both days.  
Dinner will be provided at Raumati Bowling Club on night 1 (included in budget)
